## A word from the Principal

Thank you in advance for all the work that has gone into the children preparing through their 'run jump throw' program for The Terrace School Athletics Day.

This day has been set aside for all children to have a chance to experience what it is like to compete in an athletics event.

The most important first step is that the child lines up and gives each activity a go to the best of their ability. For some that could mean a personal best or PB - they have jumped higher or longer than ever before...

Other children are also trying to run or jump or throw to qualify for an event in the Central Otago Athletics Day. Of course not everyone can be selected, below is our criteria:

*Students need to:*

- Display positive participation in and be successful in the school's 'Run Jump Throw' physical education program.
- Achieve 1<sup>st</sup> through to 4<sup>th</sup> in the sprint event at The Terrace School Athletics.
- Achieve 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, or third in other events that have a corresponding event at the Central Otago Athletics.
- Meet any required qualifying standard.

*If a student is away on The Terrace Athletics Sports Day and has a current history at the Alexandra Athletics Club or at school practices of; times, distances etc, that are better than the 'TTS Athletics place getters' then the achiever then becomes eligible to represent the school and replaces the lowest place getter who might otherwise have been deemed eligible.*

*Students will need to demonstrate the qualities necessary to represent their school in a positive manner.*

Congratulations to the school for their powhiri for our Iowa State (USA) teachers. It was a special welcome lead ably by Samuel Waitoa and Ethan Knights responded so well on behalf of our guests.

The PTA is once again running the canteen for the CO Sports and we need some additional parent help to run this.

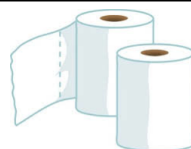
