In June 2008 the first ice luge track opened in the Southern Hemisphere, at Naseby. The track, a Natural track is a variation of the more commonly known Olympic (artificial track) luge.

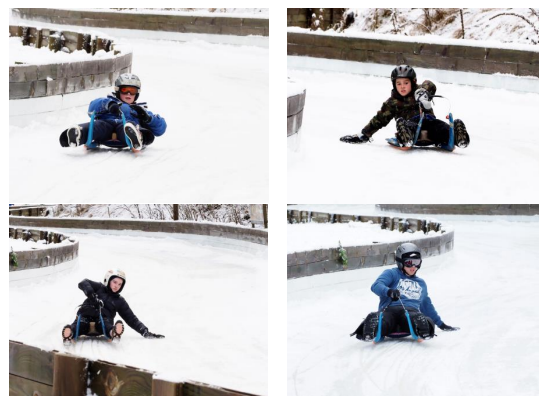
New Zealanders have been competing in luge (both Olympic and Natural) since 1987 with graduates of the Naseby Luge Track competing overseas since 2011. Highlights include Jack Leslie winning the overall Junior World Cup title in Natural Luge in 2016 and placing 5th in the 2017 World Championships, Angela Paul competing in the 1998 (Nagano, Japan) and 2002 (Salt Lake City, USA) Olympic Winter Games and Matheson competing in the inaugural Winter Youth Olympic Games in Austria in 2012. Since 2012 athletes have travelled to Europe every season to train and compete in international races. The IOC are currently considering Natural Track Luge for the 2022 Beijing Olympic Winter Games.

With its curling, skating, and luge facilities, Naseby is New Zealand's 'Ice Capital' and a family winter sports paradise.

Curling

Curling is a sport in which players slide heavy, polished granite stones, also called "rocks", across a sheet of ice towards a target area. Curling was invented in Scotland, with the first written reference to a contest coming from 1541. We use lighter weight wooden Bavarian ice stocks to teach curling basics.

Ice Skating

Skating is moving on ice by using ice skates. The earliest skating happened in Finland about 4,000 years ago using sharpened, flattened bones strapped to the bottom of the foot.

The outdoor artificially refrigerated Maniototo Ice Rink opened in the early 1990s and was upgraded in 2010 and 2011.

Luge

Luge is a small sled ridden face up and feet-first. Steering is done by flexing the sled's runners with the leg or exerting opposite shoulder pressure with reins. Lugging originated in Switzerland with the first races taking place in 1885.

In June 2008 the first ice luge track in the Southern Hemisphere opened at Naseby.
